GONNA KICK OFF THE SHOW NICE AND FINE. AND SPIN A NEW OLD FAVORITE OF MINE.

#### **SCENE 2**

Roger. I was just asking.

Kenickie. Yes, well I was working.

Roger. Working!?

Kenickie. Hey! I'm saving up to buy a car.

**Roger.** Great! What kind?

**Kenickie.** I don't know what kind yet, stupid. But I have already chosen the name.

Roger. Oh yes?

Kenickie. Yes. "Greased Lightning".

**Roger.** Oh, great! What style! (*He laughs.*)

Kenickie. Yes, laugh, laugh. When you see me in it, you all will be crying.

**Roger.** Will we? (He reads his class time-table.) Damn.

Kenickie. Hey, what are you saying, Roger?

Roger. I've got old Lady Lynch for English again. She hates me so much.

**Kenickie.** No, I think she likes you, my friend. That's why she continues to have you back in her class.

Roger. Oh yes?... Well, this year, she's going to wish she'd never met me.

**Kenickie.** Yes, what are you going to do to her?

**Roger.** I'm simply not going take any of her rubbish, that's all. I don't take rubbish from anybody.

**Lynch** (entering). What's all the noise out here?

Roger. Hello, Miss Lynch, we were... Uh...

**Lynch** (cutting them off). Aren't you supposed to be in class right now?

Roger. Well, I... I... Uh...

**Lynch.** It's a nice way to start the new semester. Well, are you going to stand there all day?

All. No, Miss.

**Lynch.** Then move!!!

Miss Lynch exits.

All. Yes, Miss.

**Kenickie.** I'm sure glad she didn't give you any of her rubbish, my friend. You'd have really told her off, wouldn't you?

Roger. Ahhh, shut up.

**Kenickie.** After school I'll go to choose my car.

#### **SCENE 3**

Yard of Rydell High School.

**Rizzo.** My God, I wish it was still summer. It's only a quarter past twelve and I feel like I have been here a whole year.

Marty. Yes, how boring.

Rizzo. Hey, Marty, who do you have for Economics? Old Mr. Drucker?

Marty. Yes, how boring. He keeps making passes at the girls.

**Rizzo.** Really? He never tried anything with me!

Marty. Oh, this is true.

Rizzo. Hey, where are all the girls?

Frenchy and Sandy enter.

Frenchy. Hi, girls.

Pink Ladies. Hey, hey, hey!

**Frenchy.** This is my new neighbour, Sandy Dumbrowski. This is Rizzo, and that's Marty.

Marty. Hi.

**Sandy.** Hi. I'm pleased to meet you.

**Frenchy.** Hey, Marty, are those new glasses?

**Marty.** Yes, I use them only for school. Do they make me look more intelligent?

Rizzo. No! We can still see your face.

Marty. Be careful, Rizzo!!!

Marty exits.

**Rizzo.** Hey Sandy, how do you like the school so far?

**Sandy.** Oh, it seems really nice. I was supposed to go to Immaculata, but my father had a fight with the Mother Superior over my patent leather shoes.

Frenchy. What do you mean?

**Sandy.** Well, she said the boys could see up my dress in the reflection.

All laugh.

Rizzo. Hey, where do you buy shoes like that?

Patty. Hi, girls!

**Rizzo.** Hey, look who's coming. It's Patty Simcox. The little Lulu of Rydell High.

Patty. Oh, I just love the first day of school, don't you?

**Rizzo.** It's the biggest thrill of my life.

**Patty.** You will never guess what happened this morning!

Rizzo. Probably not.

**Patty.** Well, they announced the nominees for the Student Council, and guess who's nominated for Vice President?

All Girls. Who?

Patty. Me! Isn't that fantastic?

Rizzo. Fantastic!

Patty (to Sandy). Oh, hi.

Sandy. Hi. I'm Sandy Dumbrowski.

Patty. It's a real pleasure, Sandy. We are very glad to have you here at Rydell.

#### **SCENE 4**

Rydell High School. Boys enter from opposite side of the girls. The two groups don't speak each other.

Group of the Boys.

Kenickie. Hey, isn't that Danny over there? (Shouts.) Hey, Danny!

**Danny** (entering). Hey, you guys, what are you doing? (Jokes with them.)

Roger. Where've you been all summer, Danny?

**Danny.** Well, I spent a lot of time at the beach.

**Kenickie.** Hey, did you meet anyone interesting?

Danny. No, only this girl... Very nice, you know?

**Roger.** Did you have fun? Sandy. MET A BOY, CUTE AS CAN BE **Danny.** Is that all you ever think about, Roger? **SUMMER DAYS** Both. DRIFTING AWAY TO AH, OH Roger. Tell us, come on! THOSE SUMMER NIGHTS. Group of the Girls. Boys. A-WELL-A, WELL-A, WELL-A HUH! TELL ME MORE, TELL ME MORE **Sandy.** I spent most of the summer at the beach. DID YA GET VERY FAR? Patty. Why? We've got a new pool right here in the neighbourhood. It's Girls. TELL ME MORE, TELL ME MORE really nice. Marty. LIKE DOES HE HAVE A CAR? **Rizzo.** Yes, if you like swimming in chlorine. Girls. UH HUH, UH HUH, UH HUH, UH HUH... **Sandy.** Well, actually, I met a boy there. Boys. DO DO DO DO DO DO DO DO DO... **Frenchy.** And all for a boy? Danny. SHE SWAM BY ME, SHE GOT A CRAMP **Sandy.** Well, it was a special boy. **Rizzo.** Are you joking? There isn't any such thing. Sandy. HE RAN BY ME, GOT MY SUIT DAMP Group of the Boys. Danny. SAVED HER LIFE, SHE NEARLY DROWNED **Danny.** Okay, guys, do you want to know what happened? Sandy. HE SHOWED OFF, SPLASHING AROUND Boys ad libitum in response. Both. SUMMER SUN Group of the Girls. SOMETHING'S BEGUN, THEN UH, OH THOSE SUMMER NIGHTS **Sandy.** No, he was really nice. It was all very romantic. All. A-WELL-A, WELL-A, WELL-A HUH! All sing "Summer nights". Girls. TELL ME MORE, TELL ME MORE Danny. SUMMER LOVIN' HAD ME A BLAST **Frenchy.** WAS IT LOVE AT FIRST SIGHT? Sandy. SUMMER LOVIN' HAPPENED SO FAST

MET A GIRL, CRAZY FOR ME

Danny.

TELL ME MORE, TELL ME MORE

Boys.

**Kenickie.** DID SHE PUT UP A FIGHT? Girls. DUM DOOBIE DOO DOOBIE DOO DOOBIE DOO... Danny. TOOK HER BOWLING, IN THE ARCADE Sandy. WE WENT STROLLING, DRANK LEMONADE Danny. WE MADE OUT, UNDER THE DOCK WE STAYED OUT, 'TILL TEN O'CLOCK Sandy. Both. SUMMER FLING DON'T MEAN A THING, BUT UH, OH THOSE SUMMER NIGHTS WOOH, WOOH, WOOH Boys. TELL ME MORE, TELL ME MORE BUT YA DON'T GOTTA BRAG Roger. Girls. TELL ME MORE, TELL ME MORE Rizzo. 'CAUSE HE SOUNDS LIKE A DRAG All. SHUDA BOP BOP, SHUDA BOP BOP Sandy. HE GOT FRIENDLY HOLDING MY HAND Danny. SHE GOT FRIENDLY DOWN IN THE SAND Sandy. HE WAS SWEET, JUST TURNED EIGHTEEN SHE WAS GOOD, YA KNOW WHAT I MEAN Danny. Both. SUMMER HEAT BOY AND GIRL MEET, THEN AH, OH THOSE SUMMER NIGHTS

WOOH, WOOH, WOOH

Girls. TELL ME MORE, TELL ME MORE Rizzo. HOW MUCH DOUGH DID HE SPEND? Boys. TELL ME MORE, TELL ME MORE COULD SHE GET ME A FRIEND? Roger. Sandy. IT TURNED COLDER, THAT'S WHERE IT ENDS Danny. SO I TOLD HER, WE'D STILL BE FRIENDS Sandy. THEN WE MADE OUR TRUE LOVE VOW WONDER WHAT SHE'S DOIN' NOW Danny. Both. SUMMER DREAMS RIPPED AT THE SEAMS, BUT, OH THOSE SUMMER NIGHTS All. TELL ME MORE, TELL ME MORE **Frenchy.** My God Sandy, he sounds wonderful. **Rizzo.** A guy doesn't touch you and it's true love. I don't believe it. **Frenchy.** What if we said that about Danny Zuko. Sandy. Did you say, Danny Zuko? My Danny, the one I met this summer? He told me he was going to Lake Forest Academy?

Rizzo. That's a laugh!

 $\textbf{\textit{Patty.}} \ Listen, Sandy, forget\ Danny\ Zuko.\ I\ know\ some\ really\ handsome\ boys.$ 

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Rizzo. So do I. Right guys? Come on, let's go.

Frenchy. Let's go Sandy. See you around, Patty!

Sandy. Yes, maybe we'll see you at the next Student Council meeting.

Patty exits.

All Girls. And maybe we won't!

Roger and Danny enter.

Frenchy. Well, speaking of the devil!

Roger (to guys). What did I tell you, they're always chasing me.

Frenchy (pushing Roger away). Not you! Hey, Danny.

**Rizzo.** Yes. We've got a surprise for you.

Danny. Sandy!

Sandy. Danny!

Sandy and Danny ad libitum to each other.

**Danny** (to guys). ... Strange girl.

Boys ad libitum mutters of acknowledgement, focus away from Danny.

**Danny** (to Sandy). I thought you were going to Immaculata.

Sandy. I changed my plans.

Boys look at Danny's reaction.

**Danny.** Great. Yes, well, I guess, I'll see you around. Let's go guys.

The boys go away.

Roger. Where do you know her from, Danny?

**Danny.** Huh? Oh, she's just an old friend of the family.

**Roger** (to Danny). She's beautiful. I think she's got eyes for me, did you notice?

Sandy looks towards Danny.

**Sandy.** I don't understand it. He was so nice with me this summer.

Frenchy. Forget him, Sandy.

Marty enters again.

Rizzo. Ah, look who's there!

**Marty.** Hey, listen, how would you like to come over to my house tonight? It'll be just us girls.

**Frenchy.** Yes, those guys are a bunch of idiots.

**Rizzo.** Yes, and Zuko's the biggest idiot of all. Right girls?

Marty. Yes.

Rizzo. Come on, let's go.

School bell rings.

#### **SCENE 5**

Marty's Bedroom. A pyjama party. Marty, Frenchy, Sandy and Rizzo are in pyjamas. WAXX jingle for the Vince Fontaine show is on the radio.

**W.A.X.X. Jingle.** THE SUNNY SOUND OF RADIO, IN YOUR OWN NEIGHBOURHOOD... VINCE FONTAINE THE MAIN BRAIN ON W.A.X.X... NOW!

**Vince V-O.** Hey, hey, this is the main-brain, Vince Fontaine, at Big Fifteen! Here at the House of Wax. (*Ooo-ga horn sound.*) W-A-X-X. Time, 10.46. (*Ricocheting bullet effect.*) Sharp-shooter pick hit of the week!

Lively music starts and all the girls dance except for Sandy.

**Marty.** Come on Sandy, dance with us... So you will warm up a bit.

**Rizzo.** I don't' think so, with what she has put on...

Rizzo points at Sandy's long robe buttoned up to her neck.

**Frenchy** (taking Sandy by hand and letting her get up off the bed). Come!

**Rizzo.** I'll bet you Sandy has never been to a pyjama party before, or...

**Sandy.** Yes, I have. I went to my cousin's wedding party once.

**Rizzo.** Oh, ring-a-ding-ding.

The girls involve her in the dance.

**Rizzo.** I nearly forget! This is going to warm us up.

Rizzo takes out some beers from her bag.

Marty. It's clear, I prefer dark.

**Rizzo.** Yes, content yourself with this, princess Grace. Hey Sandy, do you want one?

**Sandy.** Oh, I'm fine, thank you.

Rizzo. I'm sure you have never drunk one in your life.

Sandy shakes her head.

**Marty.** You haven't missed anything, trust me.

**Rizzo.** Do you ever wear earrings? I think they'd help to make your face look less thin.

**Frenchy.** Would you like me to pierce your ears for you, Sandy? I'm going to be a beautician, you know.

Rizzo. Yes, she's really good. She did mine for me.

**Frenchy.** Good. Hey, Marty, is there a needle around?

Marty. Hey, how about my drawing pin!

**Frenchy.** Nice to know it's good for something.

Girls laugh.

**Marty.** What's that supposed to mean?

Frenchy. Forget it, Marty. I was just teasing you.

Marty. Yes, well, tease someone else. It's my house.

Sandy. Ouch!

**Frenchy.** Hey, hold still, okay?

**Marty.** Hey, Frenchy... Why don't you take Sandy to the bathroom? My old lady would kill me if we got blood all over the place.

Sandy. Huh?

**Frenchy.** It only bleeds for a second. Let's go.

Rizzo. Aaaawww! I miss all the fun!

**Sandy.** Listen, Frenchy, I'm sorry, but I'm not feeling too well, and I...

**Rizzo.** Look, Sandy, if you think you're going to be hanging around with the Pink Ladies, you've got to do it! Otherwise, forget it... And go back to your hot cocoa and Girl Scout cookies!

Sandy. Okay... Let's go, Frenchy.

They go towards the exit.

**Marty.** Hey, Sandy, don't worry about it. If she screws up, I can always fix your hair so your ears won't show.

Frenchy. Har-dee-har-har!

Frenchy and Sandy exit.

**Rizzo.** That girl's becoming really boring.

Marty. Hey, leave her alone, Rizzo.

**Rizzo.** Yes, well, how long are we supposed to be a baby sitter for her? That girl's a real little Sandra Dee, isn't she?

Frenchy comes back.

Marty. Where is Sandy?

**Frenchy.** She went out to take a little fresh air.

**Rizzo.** Let's hope she stays out. She is really boring.

Rizzo sings "Look at me, I'm Sandra Dee".

#### SCENE 6

Inside a local garage. An old car centre stage.

**Roger.** Turn, re-turn, but this car won't move from here a millimetre. Let's sell these hubcaps to someone, before Kenickie realises it.

**Danny**. At eleven o'clock in the evening? Sure, maybe we could sell them to the police!

**Roger.** The police, what a laugh! Everybody knows they don't use these kind of hubcaps on police cars.

Rizzo (entering). Hey, you guys!

Roger. Hey, it's Rizzo. What do you say, Riz?

Rizzo. Usual words.

Danny. What are you doing, Riz? Have you got a new job or something?

**Roger.** Yes. She's at work right now.

Rizzo. Yes, right, Roger. Don't you wish.

Danny . Hey, wait a minute... It's Kenickie.

Kenickie enters.

**Kenickie.** All right, put those things back in my car.

**Roger.** My God, what a grouch! We were only holding them for you so that nobody would steal them.

**Rizzo.** Hey, what took you so long? What's this, a new toy of yours? (*Showing the car.*)

**Kenickie.** Isn't it cool?

**Rizzo.** Yeah, about as cool as a smashed truck.

**Kenickie.** Okay, Rizzo, if that's how you feel, why don't you all go back to your little pyjama party? Many girls would get down on their knees to ride around in this car.

**Rizzo.** Yes, sure they would! Hey, what are we going to do?

**Kenickie.** Alright, look, give me five minutes... What would you say if I pick you up at the Burger Palace?

**Rizzo.** In five minutes?

**Kenickie.** Yes, I'll be ready... As soon as I'm free of the deadwood.

Danny. See you around Riz.

Rizzo. Hey, Danny. Your girlfriend is at Marty's house.

**Danny.** Girlfriend... What are you talking about?

Rizzo. Sandy Dumbrowksi!... You know... Sandra Dee.

Danny. Strange girl. Kenickie, where did you get this wreck, anyway?

Sandy does awkward splits, falls down. Danny enters.

Danny. Hi, Sandy.

Sandy. Oh, hi.

Danny. Hey, what happened to your ear?

Sandy. Oh, nothing.

**Danny.** Hey, uh, look, I hope you're not still angry about the first day at school. I mean, couldn't you tell I was glad to see you?

**Sandy.** I'm not sure. It looked to me like maybe you had a new girlfriend or something.

**Danny.** Are you joking? If it was up to me I wouldn't even look at another girl, only you.

Sandy. Really?

**Danny.** Uh-hu... Hey, I'll tell you something. We're having a party tomorrow evening for Frenchy. She's going to leave school before she fails again and go to a Beauty School. Will you come too.

Sandy. All right, Danny. But promise me that...

**Patty** (rushing onstage with two batons and wearing cheerleader outfit). Hiiiiiiii, Danny! Oh... Don't let me interrupt. (Gives Sandy a baton.) Here, why don't you twirl that for a while. (Taking Danny aside.) I've been dying to tell you something. Do you know what I found out after you left my house the other night? My mother thinks you're very nice. (To Sandy.) He's such a heart-throb.

**Sandy.** What were you doing at her house?

**Danny.** Ah, I was just copying some homework.

Patty. Come on Sandy, let's practise.

**Sandy.** Yes, let's! I'm just hoping to make a good impression on all those nice freshmen.

**Danny.** So, that's why you're wearing that thing, getting ready to show off your legs to a bunch of half-intelligent athletes?

Sandy. Don't tell me you're jealous, Danny.

**Danny.** What? Of that bunch of empty heads! Don't make me laugh. Hardee-har-har.

**Sandy.** Listen to who's talking. It's you who would rather spend your time copying other people's homework.

**Danny.** Patty, will you stop twirling that thing. Listen, the next time they have trials for any of those teams, I'll show you what I can do.

**Patty.** Oh, what a lucky coincidence! The track team's having trials tomorrow.

**Danny** (panic). Huh?... Okay, I'll be there.

Sandy. Promises, promises.

**Danny.** You think so, huh. Hey, Patty! (He hits Patty with a Pom Pom.) Sorry, Patty! (He touches her chest, she screams.) When did you say those trials were?

Patty. Tomorrow, tenth period on the football field.

**Danny.** Cool, I'll be there. You're going to come and watch me, aren't you?

Patty. Oh, can't I see now.

**Danny.** I'll see you there, sexy. Do the splits, give a yell. Throw a fit for old Rydell.

Danny exits.

Patty. Oooooohh, I'm so excited, aren't you?

**Sandy.** Come on, let's practice.

Patty. Yes! Come on!

Patty and Sandy sing "Rydell fight song".

HIT 'EM AGAIN RYDELL RINGTAILS
TEAR 'EM APART, RED AND WHITE
BASH THEIR BRAINS OUT
STOMP 'EM ON THE FLOOR
FOR THE GLORY OF RYDELL EVER MORE.

#### **SCENE 8**

Outside Rydell High School. Roger, Rizzo, Kenickie, Marty, Frenchy, sitting on the bleachers. Rizzo is seated on Kenickies' kneels. Danny pacing...

A portable radio playing "The Vince Fontaine Show".

**"W-A-X-X-IDENT".** THE SUNNY SOUND OF RADIO, IN YOUR OWN NEIGHBOURHOOD... VINCE FONTAINE THE MAIN BRAIN ON W.A.X.X.... NOW!

**Vince V-O.** Hey, getting' back on the rebound here for our second half. (*Cuckoo sound.*) Dancin' Word Bird Contest comin' up in half an hour, when maybe I'll call you. Hey, I think you'll like this little ditty from the city. A new group discovered by Alan Freed. Turn up the sound and stomp on the ground. Oh, yeah!!! (*Radio fades.*)

**Danny.** Hey, Frenchy, when will you start Beauty School?

**Frenchy.** Next week. I can hardly wait. No more stupid books and stupid teachers. Hey, Roger, don't maul my magazine! There's a picture of Ricky Nelson in it I want to save.

Roger. I was only looking at Shelley Farbares' photo.

Frenchy. You know, lots of people think I look just like Shelley Farbares.

Kenickie & Danny. No!!!

**Roger** (trying to back up Kenickie and Danny's opinion). You don't have a chance. You haven't got the "equipment" like hers.

**Frenchy.** I happen to know she wears falsies.

**Marty** (wearing extra-large college freshman sweater and modelling it for Danny). Hey, Danny, how would I look as a college girl?

**Danny.** Boola-boola... (He shakes his head in her chest.)

Marty. Hey, watch it! It belongs to a big guy at Holy Contrition.

**Danny.** Wait until you see me wearing one of those things. I tried out for the track team today. (Ad libitum: "Of what? Zuko, no"!)

**Marty.** Are you serious? With those?

Boys laugh.

Kenickie. Hey, Danny, here comes your friend.

**Rizzo.** Friend? (She laughs.)

Roger. Hi Sandy. What are you doing? How about a beer?

Sandy. No, thanks. I can't stay.

**Danny** (he tries to hidden his regret). Ah, can't you?

Rizzo. Then why have you come?

Sandy. I only came out to... Collect some leaves for Biology.

Sandy walks away.

**Roger.** Oh, yeah? There's some really nice yellow ones in the park. Let's go, I'll show you.

Danny follows after Roger and Sandy.

Kenickie. Hey, Danny... Aren't you going to follow them?

**Danny.** Why should I? She means nothing to me.

**Rizzo.** Yes, sure, Zuko, she is the one who is always hanging around you.

**Kenickie.** Come on Rizzo. What are you trying to do, make us think she is like you?

**Rizzo.** Well, and then? Have you got to complain maybe?

**Kenickie.** No, I couldn't because you have been stuck to my face all night. Ha Ha. (*He laughs.*)

**Rizzo.** Shut up, otherwise...

Kenickie. Oh, I'm really afraid!

Rizzo. Hey, you!

Roger (entering). Fight! Fight! Yes!

Danny. Come on, stop it!

**Kenickie.** My God, what a touchy girl! I make one little joke and she goes tutti-frutti.

**Danny.** What a couple of crazy guys.

Rizzo. Well, he started it.

Roger. Yes, nice couple.

**Danny.** And Sandy, where is she?

**Roger** (trying to make up something). I told you she likes me... She has... Even... Kissed me...

Danny makes an effort not to react and raises the volume of the radio.

**Vince V-O.** Hello everyone... I remind you that tomorrow night yours Main-Brain, Vince Fontaine, will be at Rydell High School in the boys gym, and along with me will be the Radio WAXX Show Band. So, don't miss the great dance contest tomorrow night at 7.30. ("Only You" – Radio fades.)

Rizzo. Hey, Danny, are you going to the dance tomorrow night?

**Danny.** I don't think so.

Sandy comes in again, but Rizzo doesn't see her entering.

Rizzo. Awww, you're all broken up over little Miss goody-goody!

Danny. Who?

**Rizzo.** Ahh, come on, Zuko, why don't you take me to the dance. I can help you overcome that Sandra Dee, too. Right, guys?... Look, at me I'm Sandra Dee, the saint!

**Sandy.** Listen, just who do you think you are? Why are you making fun of me?

Rizzo pushes Sandy. Sandy leaps on Rizzo and the two girls start fighting. Danny pulls Sandy off.

Sandy. Let go of me! Don't touch me!

Rizzo. That girl's angry!

**Sandy.** You tell her right now... That all those things you've been saying about me were lies. Go on, tell her.

**Danny.** I don't know what you're talking about. I never said anything about you.

**Sandy.** Boot licker! You think you're such a great man, don't you? Trying to make me look like a girl... (*Pointing at Rizzo*) among the others?

Rizzo. What...

Rizzo attacks Sandy.

**Danny.** Rizzo! (He stands between Rizzo and Sandy.) Leave her alone.

Sandy. I don't know why I ever liked you, Danny Zuko.

Sandy exits.

**Danny.** Sandy!... (To guys.) Strange girl!... (Group reacts.) Hey, Rizzo.

Rizzo. Yes.

**Danny.** Do you want to go to the dance with me?

Rizzo. Yes, sure.

Roger. Hey Frenchy.

Frenchy. Yes!

**Roger.** Can you still go to the dance, now that you left school?

**Frenchy.** Yes, I guess so. Why?

**Roger.** Oh... (All ad libitum "Ask her... Come on...".) Ah, nothing. I guess I'll see you there. Hey, Kenickie, how about giving me a lift tomorrow night? I'll pick up a couple of girls for us at the dance.

**Danny.** Ah yes? And with what? A meat hook? Ha-ha.

Kenickie. No, I can't give you a lift. I have got a blind date from across the town.

Rizzo. Oh, yes?

Kenickie. Yes, and I hear she's a real bombshell.

Marty. God, I don't even know if I'll go.

**Danny.** Why not, Marty?

Marty. I haven't got a date.

**Danny.** You haven't got a date?

Marty. No.

Danny. You'll surely find one at the dance tomorrow.

Groups laughs and ad libitum reactions during music intro.

#### **ACT II**

#### **SCENE 1**

Inside Rydell High school. Boys Gym.

Vince. Hey, hey, hey! This is Vince Fontaine, better known as Doctor Groove, the DJ on the move. So - here we are - at last - we're broadcasting directly from the boys gym at fantabulous Rydell High School; a lively night is waiting for us! Listen carefully because now we are going on stage to listen to this year's big teen talent contest winner, the beautiful Marty! She's singing "It's Raining on Prom Night".

Marty and Sandy sing "It's raining on prom night".

**Sandy** (speaking). Dear God, please let him feel the same way I'm feeling right now. Make him want to see me again and let him know that I'm the only girl in the whole wide world for him and that someday we'll make that special vow that'll bring us together for ever and

Together. IT'S RAINING, RAIN FROM THE SKIES IT'S RAINING, TEARS FROM MY EYES OVER YOU

Marty. OOH... Sandy. **RAINING RAINING** RAINING ON PROM NIGHT **RAINING** 

Vince. Stay here guys. We are going to take a five minute break but we'll be dancing again in a few minutes.

**Rizzo.** Hey, Danny, will you be my partner for the dance contest?

**Danny.** Maybe, if nothing better comes along.

**Rizzo.** Sensational!

Marty. Danny, Danny! How did the track trials go?

**Danny.** I made the team.

Marty. Oh, wonderful!

Kenickie and Cha-Cha enter together.

**Cha-Cha** (to Kenickie). My God, it's the perfect time to get here. Look, the place's half-empty already.

**Kenickie.** Ah, stop it. Could I help it if my car wouldn't start?

**Cha-Cha.** Tell it to someone else!

Danny goes near them.

**Kenickie** (to Danny). My God, what a monster, isn't it Danny...

**Danny.** Oh yes, I happened to dance with her once!

Vince goes to Marty, who was leaving.

**Vince.** Hey, weren't you a contestant in the Miss Rock and Roll Universe Pageant, too?

Marty. Oh, yes.

**Vince.** I was one of the judges. You should know that I voted only for you. You are beautiful. Do your family know I come into your room every night? Over WAXX I mean! I'm going to judge the dance contest tonight, are you going to be in it?

Marty. I think not. I haven't got a date.

**Vince.** What? A knockout like you! Things sure have changed since I went to school... Last year... Last year... Hey let me buy you a drink.

Both exit. Sandy enters.

Sandy. Hi guys.

**Rizzo.** Someone is in the way here! You've get the wrong door, little saint. This is not a library.

Sandy. I perfectly know where the library is. I am not sure you do!

Kenickie. Stop it, girls.

**Rizzo.** Hey, we need floor space for the contest. You are in the way.

Rizzo forms pair with Kenickie. Danny goes towards Sandy, but Cha-cha forms pair with him, ready to dance. Sandy looks at Danny, and then she leaves.

**Vince.** Okay, guys, here it is. The big one... The Jive Time Dance contest. I'd like to welcome you all to "Moonlight in the Tropics". (*Crowd reacts.*) Now for the rules! One. All couples must be boy-girl. (*Crowd reacts.*) Two. Anyone using tasteless or vulgar movements will be disqualified.

**Rizzo.** Like this?

Rizzo shows a movement, crowd reacts.

Vince. Three. If I tap you on the shoulder, you must leave the dance floor immediately. Only one thing I want to say, in all sincerity, is enjoy yourselves, have a ball because like we always say at "BIG FIFTEEN" where the guys hang out "if you're having fun, you're number one"! And tonight some lucky guy and girl are going to go bopping home with a stack of terrific prizes. Hey but don't feel bad if we bump you out, because it doesn't matter if you win or lose, but it's what you do with those dancing shoes. So, boys, take up your partner and... AWAY WE GO!

Vince sings "Born to hand jive".

I COULD BARELY WALK WHEN I MILKED A COW
WHEN I WAS THREE I PUSHED A PLOUGH

AND STARTED DANCIN' WHILE I GATHERED EGGS
THE TOWN FOLD CLAPPED I WAS ONLY FIVE

#### **HAND JIVE**

All clap their hands.

**Vince.** Well we have our winners. Will you step up here for your prizes? Daniel Zuko and... And...

**Cha-Cha.** Cha-Cha DiGregorio. (*Grabbing mike... Crowd boos and ad libitum.*) They call me Cha-Cha because I'm the best dancer at St. Bernadette's.

**Vince.** Oh, very well. Congratulations to both of you, and now for your prizes. Two tickets to the Starlight Drive-In Movie Theatre. (*He gives tickets to Danny.*) Weren't they terrific? Only thing I want to say before we finish is that you guys at Rydell are the greatest!

#### Crowd reacts.

Vince. Last dance, ladies' choice.

Cha-cha turns to dance with Danny again, but he runs away where Sandy exited. Prom exits slowly as scene shifts to outside Rydell High School.

#### SCENE 2

Outside Rydell High School.

**Sandy** (to herself). Danny, this time you have hurted me really bad. And then why, why can't I keep away from you...

Sandy sings "Hopelessly devoted to you".

MY EYES ARE NOT THE FIRST TO CRY
I'M NOT THE FIRST TO KNOW

BUT BABY CAN'T YOU SEE
THERE'S NOTHING ELSE FOR ME TO DO?
I'M HOPELESSLY DEVOTED TO YOU

**Sandy.** I imagined a completely different night.

**Danny.** Me, too. I am sorry. What do you think about seeing a movie at the drive-in tomorrow night? I already have the tickets.

Danny shows her the tickets he has just won at the dance contest.

**Sandy.** "I am sorry" is not enough, do you know that?

**Danny.** Come on, what do you want me to do... I have a lot of friends here, everyone knows me... They expect a lot from me.

Sandy. Oh yes? Well then, go back to them. Be like them.

**Danny.** And you, what do you expect from me?

**Sandy.** That you are yourself!

Sandy starts to leave.

Danny. Sandy wait... Can I call you tomorrow?

Sandy smiles, but Danny doesn't see her, and she goes away without answering.

#### SCENE 3

Outside the Burger Palace. Frenchy sits alone as Roger enters with zip gun. He mimes shootout and dramatic death. Kenickie enters.

**Kenickie.** Hey, Roger... Isn't it time you grew up?

**Roger.** Okay. Hey, Frenchy, what has happened? Why are you so sad? Have you left Beauty School already?

**Frenchy.** No, everything is going on very well. Hey, what's with the arsenal!

**Roger.** We've got to fight with the Flaming Dukes.

**Frenchy.** You are joking, aren't you? Why?

Kenickie. I brought Cha-Cha to the ball...

**Roger.** Yes, and then she ended up dancing with Danny. They won, too!

**Kenickie.** Well, it turns out she is going steady with the leader of the Flaming Dukes. And he found out everything.

Danny enters.

Roger. Hey, Danny.

**Kenickie.** God, Popeye, where do you keep your spinach?

Danny (reaching in front of jock strap). Ha ha. How funny.

**Roger.** Hey, it's a good thing you're here. We're supposed to fight the Dukes tonight!

Danny. Oh, yes? What time?

Kenickie. Nine o'clock.

**Danny.** I've got field training till... 9.30.

Kenickie. Can't you sneak away, man?

**Danny.** Not a chance! The Coach would throw me out immediately.

Roger. The Coach!

**Danny.** Yeah, Roger, the Coach. Besides, what am I supposed to do, step on somebody's face with my gym shoes? Look, I've got to leave, I'm in a hurry now. I'll see you guys later.

Roger. Zuko, we'll lose without you.

**Danny.** The Dukes are crazy. It is better not to provoke them.

Roger. You are saying surrender?! Zuko, are you ill by chance?

**Danny.** Guys, I am just saying that this is not worth it. I will join you later, is that okay? On your marks, get set... Go.

#### Danny runs off.

**Roger.** What's the matter with Zuko? He runs every day, he doesn't take part in fighting, the only thing missing is that he is beginning to study to enter the College. Who would have ever thought Zuko would run out on us?

**Kenickie.** Nice fight! A herd of Flaming Dukes against me and you. Do you know what, let's go and eat something, that's better.

Roger. And the fight?

Kenickie. ... We will think about that later.

#### Kenickies goes off.

**Roger.** Hey, Frenchy, maybe I'll come down to your Beauty School some night this week... We can have a Coke or something.

Frenchy (uncertain). Yes... Yes, sure.

Roger. Really?

Frenchy. Yes.

Roger. Cool. Yes!

#### Roger exits.

**Frenchy.** Awww. God! What am I going to do? I can't just tell everybody I left of Beauty School. I can't become a waitress at the Burger Palace... Not with all my friends sitting around. I wish I had one of those Guardian Angels like in that Debbie Reynolds movie. Wouldn't that be nice... Somebody always there to tell you what's the best thing to do.

Teen Angel and girls sing "Beauty School dropout".

**Hero.** There, there, you're safe now, Sheila.

**Scientist.** Poor Todd. The radiation has caused him to mutate. He's become half-man and, half-monster... Like a werewolf.

**Sheila.** But, doctor... He's my brother. And his big stock car race is tomorrow.

Hero. Great Scott! It's a full moon!

Silence. Danny stretches, puts arm across Sandy's shoulder. Danny tries to get his arm around her. She moves away.

**Danny.** Why don't you move a little closer?

**Sandy.** Is this okay?

**Danny.** That's fine, but can't you at least smile or something? Look, Sandy I practically had to break Kenickie's arm to get his car for tonight. I thought we were going to forget all about that stuff with Cha-Cha. I told you also on the phone that I was sorry.

Sandy. I know you did.

**Danny.** Well, you believe me, don't you?

**Sandy.** I guess so, it's just that everything was so much easier when it was just the two of us.

**Danny.** Hey, you 're not going out with another guy, are you?

Sandy. No. Why?

**Danny** (taking off school ring). Emh... Oh... No reason... (Has trouble removing ring... Runs thru his hair and it comes off.) I was going to ask you to take my ring.

Danny holds out the ring.

**Sandy.** Oh, Danny... I don't know what to say.

Danny. Well, you want it, don't you?

Sandy. Uh, huh.

Danny puts the ring on her finger.

**Danny.** I should have given it to you a long time ago. (*They kiss. Danny does actions to "restrain" himself.*) I really like you Sandy.

Danny kisses her more passionately.

Sandy. Danny take it easy! What are you trying to do?

**Danny.** What's the matter?

**Sandy.** Well, I mean... I thought we were just going to, you know, go steady.

Danny. Well, what do you think going steady means? Come on, Sandy!

Sandy. Stop it! I've never seen you like this.

Danny. Relax, will you, nobody's watching us!

Sandy. Danny, please, you're hurting me.

Sandy breaks away.

**Danny.** Why are you getting so shaken up? I thought I meant something to you.

**Sandy.** You do. But I'm still the same girl I was last summer. Just because you give me your ring doesn't mean we must go on too fast.

Sandy opens the car door, and gets out.

**Danny.** Hey, Sandy, wait a minute.

Sandy. I'm sorry, Danny... Maybe it's better if we forget about it.

Sandy slams car door on Danny's hand.

**Danny** (yelling). Hey, Sandy, where are you going'? You can't just walk out of a drive-in!

Danny sings "Sandy".

STRANDED AT THE DRIVE-IN BRANDED A FOOL WHAT WILL THEY SAY MONDAY AT SCHOOL?

SANDY, CAN'T YOU SEE
I'M IN MISERY?

Inside garage.

**Kenickie.** Aaaaahh, come on! You're not taking your record player already! The party's just getting' started.

Rizzo. Yes, she's going to because Zuko isn't here.

Sandy. It's not true! I didn't come here to see him.

Rizzo. No? What did you come for, then?

**Sandy.** I came because I was invited.

**Rizzo.** Yes, well, we only invited you because we needed a record player.

**Sandy.** Tomorrow is the last school day. Who knows when we are going to meet each other again!

**Rizzo.** It is sure that you and me won't see each other next year. You are going to College and me...

Marty. Don't mind her. Hey, Sandy, come over here.

**Rizzo.** Marty? (*She waves to make her come closer.*) I have to confide in you one thing. I think I am pregnant.

Marty. Pregnant?

Rizzo. Ssshh. Slowly. A mess, huh?

Marty. Hey, it's Kenickie, isn't it?

**Rizzo.** Hey, promise you won't tell anybody, huh?

Marty. Yes, I won't say anything.

**Rizzo.** Hey, what happened to the music? Why don't you guys play another song?

**Roger.** Okay. Hey, guys, let's play that new one by the Tinkletones?

EACH NIGHT I CRY MYSELF TO SLEEP. THE GIRL I LOVE HAS GONE FOR KEEPS... A DOO BEE DOO BEE DOO BEE...

Marty whispers to Kenickie.

Kenickie. Hey, Rizzo, I hear someone has cheated on you.

Rizzo. Oh, you do, huh? Guys, good news really travels fast!

**Kenickie.** Hey, listen, why didn't you tell me?

Rizzo. Don't worry about it Kenickie. You don't even know who the guy is.

Kenickie. What? Thanks a lot baby.

#### Kenickie exits.

**Roger.** Hey, Rizzo, what's happened? Look, if you ever need somebody to talk to...

**Rizzo.** All of a sudden you think you can do something. Get lost, Roger.

**Roger.** Listen, Rizzo, I could help you out with some money if you need it... So... For the pram or these kind of things.

**Rizzo.** Forget it, I don't want handouts.

Frenchy. Hey, it isn't so bad, Rizzo, at least you can stay home from school.

Marty. Hey, do you want to stay with me tonight, Rizzo?

**Rizzo.** Why don't you guys just go away and leave me alone?

**Sandy.** It's getting late, anyway, I guess it might be a good idea if everybody just went home. C'mon, you guys, let's go.

Roger. See you, Rizzo.

Marty. Hey, Frenchy... Wait!

Marty and Frenchy exit.

**Roger** (a Sandy). Tell her I didn't mean anything, will you.

Sandy. Yes, sure.

#### Roger exits.

Sandy. I'm sorry to hear you're in trouble, Rizzo.

**Rizzo.** Nonsense! What are you going to do, give me a whole sermon about it? Look, that's my business. It's nobody else's problem.

**Sandy.** Do you really believe that? Didn't you see Kenickie's face when he left here? It is Kenickie's, isn't it... Well, I guess I've said too much already. Good luck, Rizzo.

**Rizzo.** Now wait just a minute, Miss Goody-Goody! Who do you think you are? Handing me all this sympathy! Since you know all the answers, how come I didn't see Zuko here tonight? Listen to me, Miss Sandra Dee, you all think I am a vulgar and bad girl, but you are wrong, because I can love and suffer, too.

Rizzo sings "There are worse things I could do".

Sandy sings "Sandra Dee reprise".

LOOK AT ME, THERE HAS TO BE SOMETHING MORE THAN WHAT THEY SEE WHOLESOME AND PURE ALSO SCARED AND UNSURE, A POOR MAN'S SANDRA DEE

WHEN THEY CRITICIZE AND MAKE FUN OF ME CAN'T THEY SEE THE TEARS IN MY SMILE DON'T THEY REALIZE THERE'S JUST ONE OF ME AND IT HAS TO LAST ME A WHILE

Roger. Why?

Danny enters.

Patty. Ask him directly. Here he comes.

Patty exits.

**Danny.** Hi guys. Are you ready for the summer?

**Kenickie.** What are you up to, my friend?

**Danny.** Are you referring to the fact that I've left the team?

**Kenickie.** "I'm referring to the fact" (imitating Danny.) That you haven't told us.

**Danny.** I've been busy with... Other things.

**Kenickie.** So busy that you haven't had time for your best friends? I finished painting my car without you. Are you avoiding us by chance?

**Danny.** No... What are you saying... I wasn't avoiding you... It is that... I had to recover many subjects... I think I'll go to College next year and... I would really like to get Sandy back again.

Roger. How boring you have become, Zuko.

**Danny.** I'm trying to grow up. To become a real man... Do you understand?

**Kenickie.** And what were you before? (He laughs.)

**Roger.** You aren't succeeding, Zuko. You are talking like a little girl now! (*He laughs.*)

**Danny.** Stop that.

**Kenickie.** Come on Zuko, don't act so. You've changed so much and... Nothing is as it was before. We miss you!

**Danny.** It's that I thought you wouldn't understand me.


